A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF FOUR BILLION, TWO HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN MILLION, SEVENTY THREE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY TWO DOLLARS FOR THE ORDINARY SERVICES OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDING 31 JULY 2027

ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Fiji —

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the 2026-2027 Appropriation Act 2026.

(2) This Act comes into force on 1 August 2026.

Appropriation of \$4,237,073,252

2. A sum of \$4,237,073,252 is to be issued from the Consolidated Fund or other funds of the State and applied to the ordinary services of the Government for the year ending 31 July 2027, and such sum is to be appropriated for the purposes specified in schedules 1 and 2 and also in the 2026-2027 Budget Estimates.

Government borrowing

3. The Government borrowing for 2026-2027 must not exceed the sum of \$1,481,863,410.

2026-2027 APPROPRIATION BILL 2026

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Bill and is intended only to indicate its general effect)

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The 2026-2027 Appropriation Bill 2026 (**‘Bill’**) makes provision for the estimate of capital and current expenditure for the ordinary services of the Government for the financial year 2026-2027.

2.0 CLAUSES

- 2.1 Clause 1 of the Bill provides for the short title and commencement. If passed by Parliament, the new legislation will come into force on 1 August 2026.
- 2.2 Clause 2 of the Bill appropriates the sum of \$4,237,073,252 for the ordinary services of the Government for the financial year ending 31 July 2027 for the purposes specified in schedules 1 and 2 to the Bill and the 2026-2027 Budget Estimates.
- 2.3 Clause 3 of the Bill provides that the Government borrowing for 2026-2027 must not exceed \$1,481,863,410.

3.0 MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- 3.1 The new legislation comes under the responsibility of the Minister responsible for finance.
